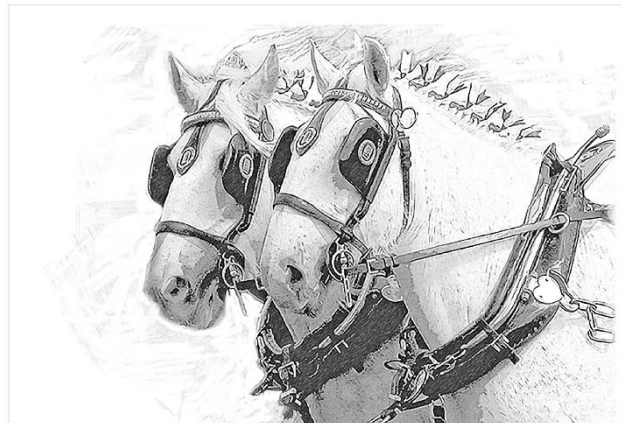

- 3 Young Stock – open to a yearling, 2 or 3-year-old**
- 4 In Hand Championship**
- 5 Young Handlers (10–18 years on Show day)**
- 6 Turnout for a Single or a Pair – Trade/Agricultural /Implement**
- 7 Ridden Class**
- 8 Fancy Dress**

A Heavy Horse Parade in the Main Ring has been scheduled for 1:30pm, for in-hand, ridden, wagons etc. Attendance is required for all. (Depending on Class Entries we will “slot” the parade ring around the classes – possibly after class 4 but to be confirmed nearer the time or on the day).
